Welcome to the second edition of the BIM4D Project Newsletter! Since our last update, the project has made significant strides in developing green and digital skills for the construction sector, focusing on Building Information Modelling (BIM) for end-of-life (EOL) practices.

Currently, our primary focus is on Development and Delivery of BIM4D Training, including:

- Design of the BIM4D Training Curriculum, structured into six (6) key training modules.
- Development of an online learning platform using LEARNDASH, integrated into the official BIM4D website.
- Creation of training materials to support industry professionals, VET providers, and policymakers in adopting BIM for sustainable deconstruction.

2nd Face-to-Face Meeting in Athens, Greece

On 15 and 16 January 2025, the BIM4D consortium gathered at PEDMEDE's headquarters in Athens to assess progress and plan upcoming activities.

Key discussions included:

- Finalisation of the six BIM4D training modules for WP3.
- Integration of the BIM4D learning materials into the European sustainability standards (CEN/TC 350).
- Preparations for national multiplier events & policy panels.

BIM4D Aligns with New EU Protocol on CDW Management

The 2024 update of the EU Protocol for Construction & Demolition Waste (CDW) Management provides critical new guidelines on:

- Mandatory pre-demolition audits to increase material recovery.
- Stronger focus on hazardous waste separation and tracking.
- Promotion of BIM and digital tools to improve waste management efficiency.
